

Aberlady Village Hall Weddings



Picturesque Aberlady Village Hall is located close to the main road in Aberlady, a short distance from Sea Green that leads onto Aberlady Bay, and within walking distance of the local church. The high roofed stone hall, has attractive exposed steel frames, a log burning fire place, a stage and a kitchen, and provides a beautiful backdrop for a wedding.

Two weekend hire packages are available for Weddings, our 'Home Grown' and our 'Outside Help'. Details of these two offerings, as well as good to know information is located on the following pages.

Home Grown: £ 500



This package is for those who are seeking to use their own friends and family skill set to build a unique wedding tailored around their own theme.

Included

- Exclusive Hall let from 17:00 on Friday night to 12:00 on Sunday afternoon
- Access to hall tables and chairs
- Access to kitchen and additional beer fridges
- 3 visits prior to the wedding day to view, plan and measure

Outside Help: £ 750



This package is for those who wish to bring in external caterers, kitchen equipment or tables and chairs. Experience has shown that the firms that hire these deliver on a Friday and collect on a Monday, and can not specify a time during those days for delivery.

Included

- Exclusive Hall let from 17:00 on Friday night to 12:00 on Sunday afternoon
- Access to hall tables and chairs
- Access to kitchen and additional beer fridges
- 3 visits prior to the wedding day to view, plan and measure and show any catering staff around
- A local contact on call during the Friday and Monday of the wedding to facilitate hire company drop off and collection

Good to know



As the hall is in a residential area, we try to keep noise to a minimum level. The external doors need to be kept shut. Last orders on the bar is 11.00pm, last dance to finish at 11.15pm, and a curfew of 11.30pm. We ask that no recycling occurs after 10.30pm.

We have a hall keeper who will appear during the set up to introduce himself, and then return to supervise the wind down and again on the Sunday to check how the tidy up is going.

Hall capacity is 150 people.

The hall booker is responsible for the fire safety and evacuation of the building.

The hall does not have an alcohol licence so any cash bar will need a licence purchased from East Lothian council.

The hall measures 25.4m long x 10.4m deep

The stage measures 6.15m long x 18.4m wide

We have 20 rectangular tables 6ft x 2.5ft, each seat 8 people.

We have 150 plastic stacking chairs, and chair trolleys to move them.

There are 12 maroon material chairs on the stage that can be used.

There are 4 high chairs

Walls can be decorated with bunting etc hanging from hooks on the picture rail. Please no blue tac on the walls.

There is a permanent fairy light strip around the wall, and overhead lights. There are additional lights on the stage.

We expect all hall users to tidy up, brush floors, stack chairs and empty bins leaving the hall ready for the next user.

If you are using external caterers we do request that they take away with them the excess rubbish, and cardboard that is generated. We have only limited bin storage and recycling facilities. We also request that any equipment that they bring is PAT tested and approved.
