Aberlady Village Hall - 2022 Improvements

If you don't already know about it, the Aberlady Village Hall is tucked off the main road on Sea Wynd; it is on your right-hand side as you turn the corner from Main Street, heading towards Gullane. Please come and see us if you have never been.

The hall was built in 1883 by The Weymss & March Estate, originally as a drill hall. In 1951 the hall was gifted to the village and is now held in trust and administered by The Aberlady Community Association (ACA), a voluntary group, open to all local residents, who look after the maintenance and day to day running of the hall. It is a challenging job.
