Defibrillators

As part of a project with the charity, 'Together in Health', the ACA support team shared their knowledge and experience of organising and managing defibrillators. Having completed an audit of all known defibrillators in the NB coastal area, the charity successfully applied for funding for 10 new public access defibrillators and external cabinets. We're very pleased that one of these will be placed at Ballencrieff Steadings over the next couple of months and will be available 24/7.

Community Resilience Volunteers
